<ul> <li>Transparent jugs (various sizes)</li> <li>Transparent containers (various sizes)</li> <li>Transparent funnels (various sizes)</li> <li>Transparent tubes</li> <li>Transparent pipettes</li> <li>Sponges</li> <li>Floating &amp; sinking balls</li> <li>Corks</li> <li>Shapes</li> <li>Boats</li> <li>Ducks</li> <li>Animals</li> <li>Letters/ numbers</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Introduce new words in the context of play,</li> <li>Help children expand on what they say, introducing and reinforcing the use of more complex sentences.</li> <li>Use descriptive words</li> <li>Introduce vocabulary to enable children to talk about their observations and experiences,</li> <li>Demonstrate the language for measures in discussions 'full' and 'empty'.</li> <li>Teach children skills of how to use tools and materials effectively and safely and give them opportunities to practise them.</li> <li>Explain why safety is an important factor in water play, and have sensible rules for everybody to follow,</li> <li>Support children's responses to different textures.</li> <li>Talk to children to notice changes in properties of water soaked toys, bubbles, temperature etc</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>(22-36mths)</li> <li>Beginning to make-believe by pretending.</li> <li>Notices detailed features of objects in their environment.</li> <li>Shows control in holding and using jugs to pour.</li> <li>May be beginning to show preference for dominant hand.</li> <li>Beginning to be independent in self-care, but still often needs adult support.</li> <li>(30-50mths)</li> <li>Beginning to be interested in and describe the texture of things.</li> <li>Builds stories around toys.</li> <li>Comments and asks questions about aspects of their familiar world.</li> <li>Can talk about some of the things they have observed.</li> <li>Talks about why things happen and how things work.</li> <li>Uses one-handed tools and equipment,</li> <li>Can usually manage washing and drying hands.</li> <li>(40-60 mnths)</li> <li>Orders two items by capacity.</li> <li>Handles tools safely and with increasing control.</li> <li>Shows a preference for a dominant hand.</li> <li>Practices some appropriate safety measures without direct supervision.</li> </ul>
