## What are we learning in math's next week (week commencing 14.10.19)?

Reception will be sorting objects into groups that are the same – colour, size, shape, etc.

Year 1 will begin to build our number skills by partitioning a number into two or more parts and this will help with number bonds and addition. We will be working with the part - whole model....which the children will learn as part, part whole language e.g.



Year 2 will be continuing learning to recall all number bonds to and within 10 and use these to reason with and calculate bonds to and within 20.
