Weekly Phonics Tasks

Monday- Rainy Day Relay

Write some words to describe different ways you can travel, on different pieces of paper (raindrops). Your child will pick up a piece of paper and read the word. They then have to move in that way. Pick another piece of paper and repeat.

For children working in Phase 1, you 'sound out' the word for them to blend the sounds together.

Suitable words for each phase could be:

Phase 2: run, hop, kick

Phase 3: jog, march, quick feet,

Phase 4: splash, stomp, skip, jump, stamp

Phase 5: leap, tiptoe, wade, squat, dance, walk

Weekly Writing Tasks	Weekly Maths Tasks REMEMBER – Odd numbers end in 1, 3, 5, 7 or 9. Even numbers end in 0, 2, 4, 6 or 8.
Monday- Saying goodbye and thank you at the end of an experience, is a very important thing for us all to do. So, for our starter task this week we would like your child to write a note to someone at school who has helped them along the way this year. Perhaps you will choose to write to a friend, a dinner lady, a member of the office team, Mrs Townsend, Mr Grocock or the cook. Our school is so friendly and there are so many people who help, who will you choose? What will you say thank you for? How has this person helped? Perhaps they said hello with a cheery smile every morning? Maybe they looked after you in the playground or played with you every day. Take a photograph of your note and send it to us. Tuesday- Support your child to practise writing some digraphs (2 letters that make 1 sound) and trigraphs (three letters that make one sound). Ensure all the letters are correctly formed to help them get ready for their next class. Do it in fun ways, e.g. in shaving foam or shampoo, paint, glitter, in mud with a stick, in icing sugar or Nutella. What about cooked spaghetti? Extension - Try and see if you can write some words that include different digraphs and trigraphs e.g. oi – soil, ai – rain, air – fair.	Tuesday- Find a range of items (e.g. teddies, buttons or Lego etc) and ask your child to share the items out equally between 2 groups/people. Talk about, if they can't share the items out equally, this means it is an odd number of items. If they can share the items out equally, this means it is an even number of items.
Wednesday- Support your child to write some super sentences using our sentence starter sheet. How high could you fly? Whats the highest place to be do you think? Please see the attached super sentence starter sheet.	Wednesday – Complete the Caterpillar Odd and Even Worksheet.
Thursday- Today we would like your child to create their very own dinosaur story. What else could the dinosaur poop? Draw you story in order. You might use a piece of paper divided into boxes. Or, you could use a roll of lining paper spread out on the floor like a road map. You may even decide to draw your story in chalk along the garden path. Things to think about: - Where will your story take place? Who will the main characters be? How will the dinosaur travel? What problem do they encounter along the way?
