### What are we learning in math's next week (week commencing 28.1.19)?

Year 1 will be adding & subtracting numbers to 40. They will use apparatus to help work problems out. Developing mental maths and know how to write a number sentence using - + =.

Year 2 will be continuing to investigate multiplication facts using 2's 5's and 10's; they will begin to understand that multiplication is commutative (done in any order) e.g  $5 \times 4 = 4 \times 5$ .

We have head lice in class 5 at the moment. Please check your child's hair this weekend. We also have a case of threadworm in class 6. Children are being encouraged to wash their hands in warm soapy water whenever they can. You might like to speak to your child about the importance of hand washing. Thank you.
