What are we learning in math's next week (week commencing 13.5.19)?

Reception will be solving problems by reading and counting numbers to 20.

Year 1 will be practising counting in groups of 2s, 5s, and 10s and solve multiplication problems using arrays.

Year 2 will be learning to recognise and name some common 2-D and 3-D shapes from a group of shapes or from pictures of the shapes as well as describing the properties of the shapes (e.g. I can describe a triangle: it has 3 sides, 3 vertices and 1 line of symmetry; the pupil describes a pyramid: it has 8 edges, 5 faces, 4 of which are triangles and one is a square).
