Dear Parents/Carers

Car sharing

Driving your child to school with empty seats in your car is the least environmentally-friendly way to get them to school. However, it's still the way many of our children get to school, especially on wet days. If this is your situation, it's worth taking some time to see if you could organise it any other way, at least on some days. **Car sharing** is a simple solution that would ease the awful parking situation around our school.

We strongly encourage walking to and from school and car sharing. We request parents and carers observe the parking restrictions around the school and consider other pedestrians, road users and neighbours.

Parents/carers are advised to park first at Stocksbridge Leisure Centre, and then walk to school.

Parents/carers should not double park as this causes an obstruction on the road. Drivers are advised not to park on the yellow zigzag lines. These markings are necessary to allow a clear and unobstructed view for vehicles pulling out of the school grounds.

We respectfully request parents and carers be considerate to our neighbours living near the school and avoid obstructing driveways at all times.
