# What are we learning in math's next week (week commencing 29.4.19)?

Year 1 will be adding 2 numbers together using counters, 100 squares and money.

Year 2 will be learning to understand the value of different coins and learning to use different coins to make the same amount (e.g. on a number line or using coins to make 50p in different ways and knowing how to work out how many £2 coins are needed to exchange for a £20 note).

Dependent on take up we sometimes have to limit the number of places we offer so delay could mean your child not getting a place until the spring term 2020.
