### What are we learning in maths next week (week commencing 3.2.20)?

Reception will be looking at weight. We will be weighing different objects and seeing which are heavy and which are light. We will also be looking at trying to find objects that are the same weight as each other, as we will be looking at what balancing means.

Year 1 will be working with numbers to 50. Counting forwards and backwards from any given number. Being able to recognise tens and ones in a number and count, read and write numbers to 50 in numerals.

Year 2 will be consolidating their understanding of recalling and using **division** facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables to solve simple problems.
